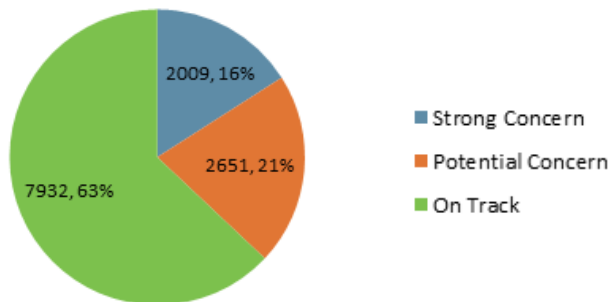

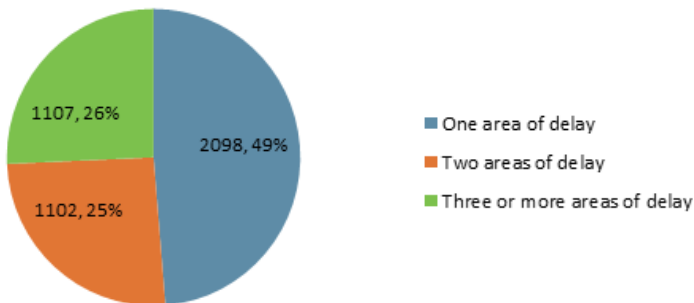

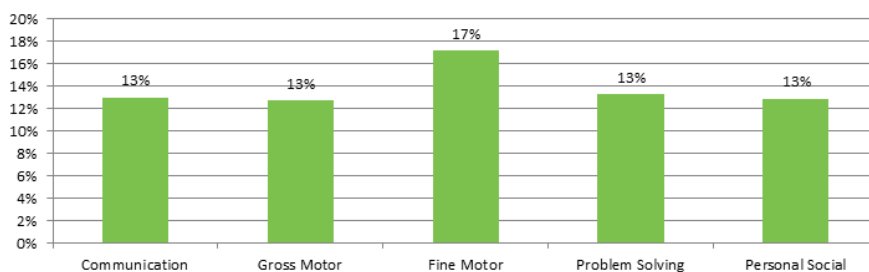
Number of Areas of Delay

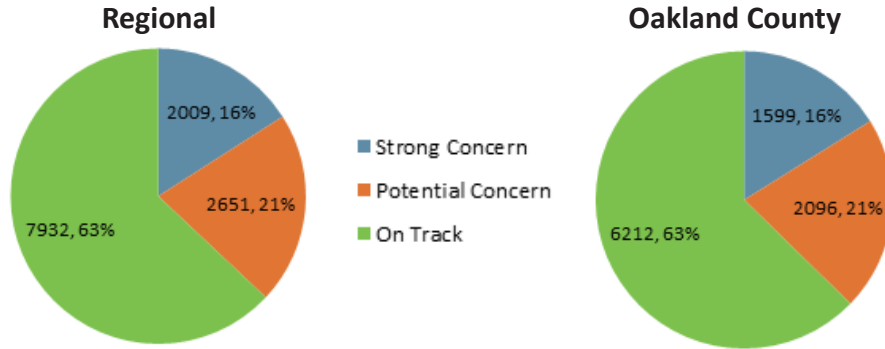

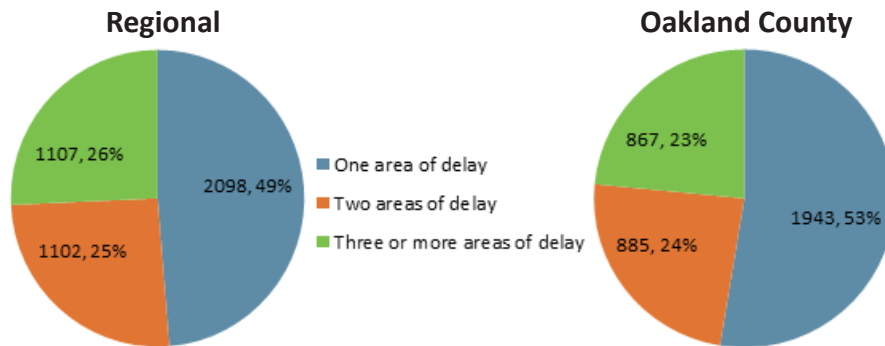

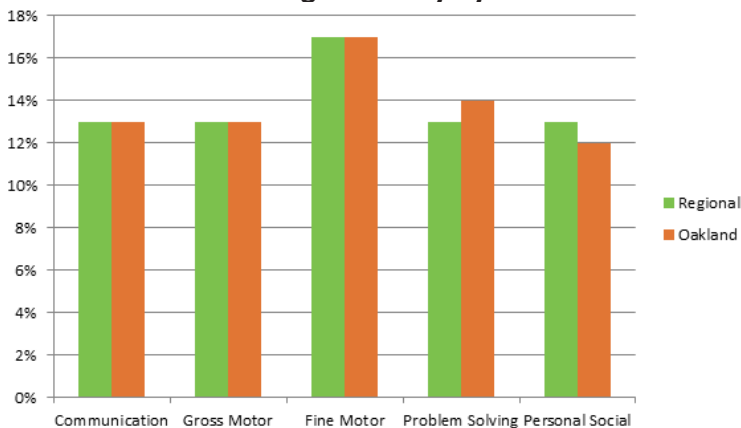

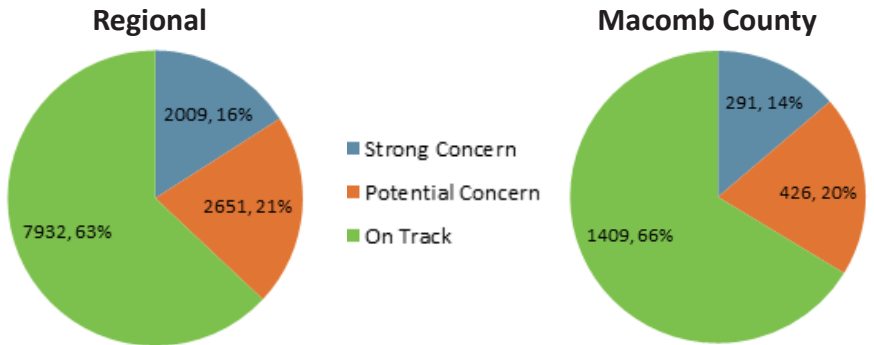

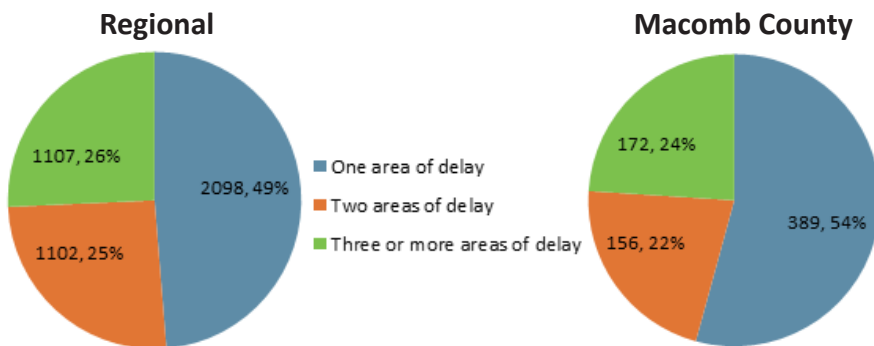

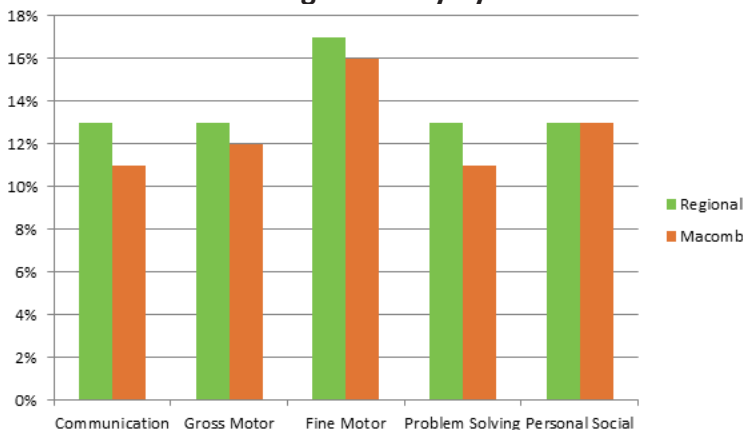

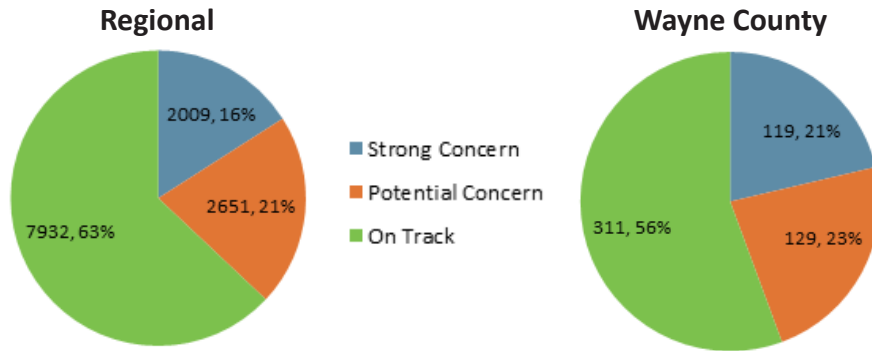

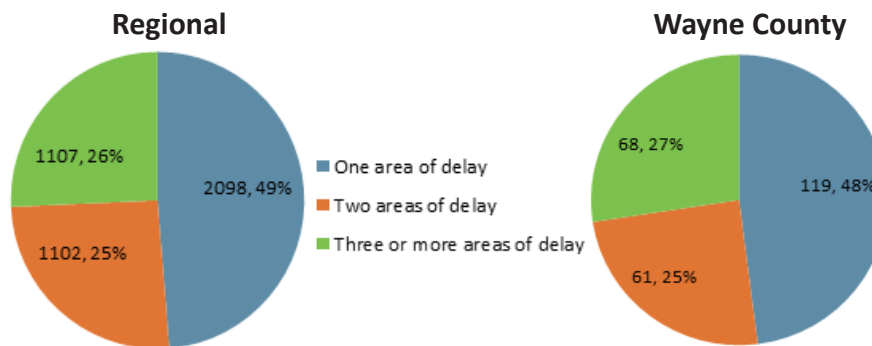

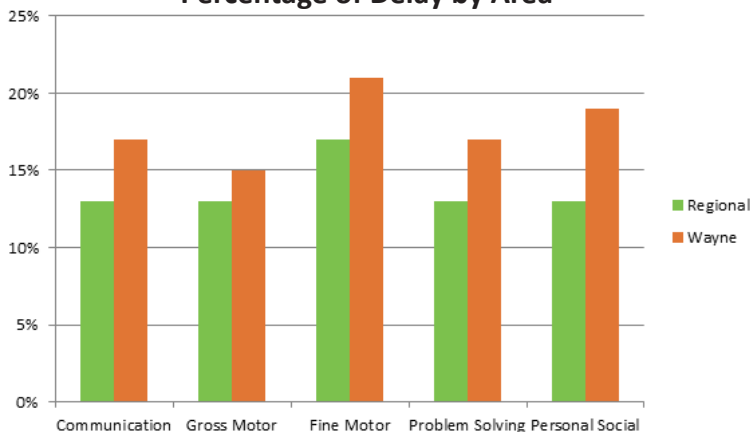

Percentage of Delay by Area

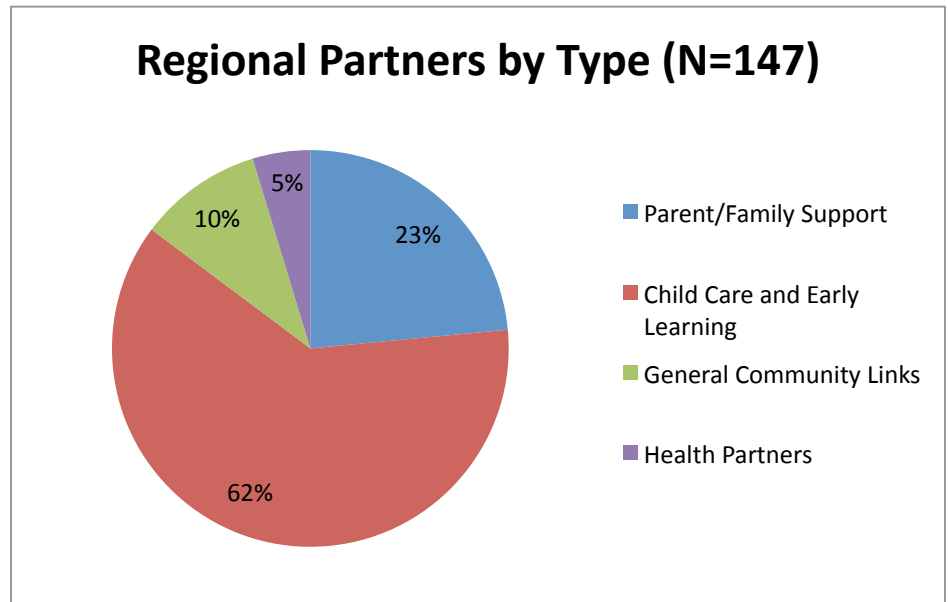
