PLANNING & IMPLEMENTATION STATUS

Oregon is very excited about our new 211info *Help Me Grow* Program Manager, who is based in the statewide 211info system. Building on multidisciplinary relationships and creating a foundation and infrastructure for integrated early childhood programs in Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties, the Program Manager will improve outcomes for children and families by coordinating the development of a three-county *HMG* system.

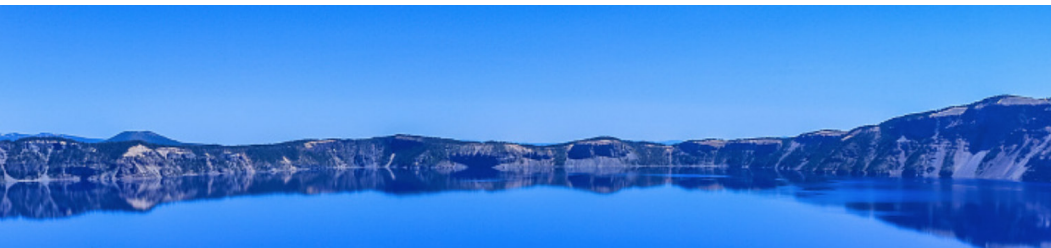
OUR HMG SYSTEM

HELP ME GROW CORE COMPONENTS

- Child Health Provider Outreach** START is one of our *HMG* flagship initiatives. START reaches out to medical clinics and provides Quality Improvement trainings on a variety of topics including developmental screening, screening and management of autism, behavioral integration and trauma-informed care.
- Centralized Phone Access Point** 211info has a statewide database with over 42,000 programs accessible to families and providers. 211info Family provides callers with resources to address parenting needs in some counties; the goal is to expand 211info Family coverage statewide.
- Family and Community Outreach** Oregon's Early Learning Hubs across the state reach out to their respective communities and engage families in focus groups and advisory committees to inform their work assuring that all children enter kindergarten ready to succeed.
- Data Collection & Analysis** Oregon state policies call for developmental screening of all children. Our state data system reports rates of screening as indicated by Medicaid billing for all communities in the state.
