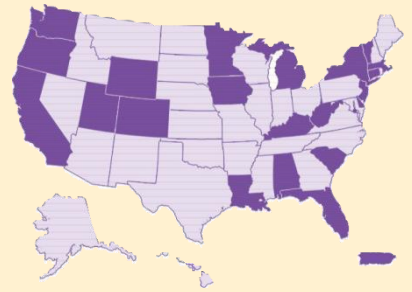

### Planning & Implementation Status

The Wyoming *Help Me Grow* system is in its infancy stages. We are in the process of exploring how our system might be structured to most effectively meet the needs of our large and sparsely populated state.

We held a local forum in the summer of 2014 and had good attendance from across Wyoming and across the early childhood sector. We were also able to send a team of people to Utah to learn more about their *HMG* system and how we might integrate some of their ideas and structure. Using information from the local forum, we have successfully set up five workgroups with broad representation from all the sectors. The workgroups have all been oriented and begun working to identify recommendations.

We will spend the next few months working through the process and looking at our options.

### Implementation of *Help Me Grow*

We have not yet fully decided if we will roll out the program at the community or state level.

### Funding Sources

The planning stages of our process are funded through Wyoming's Early Childhood Comprehensive Systems Grant from the Maternal and Child Health Bureau of HRSA.
