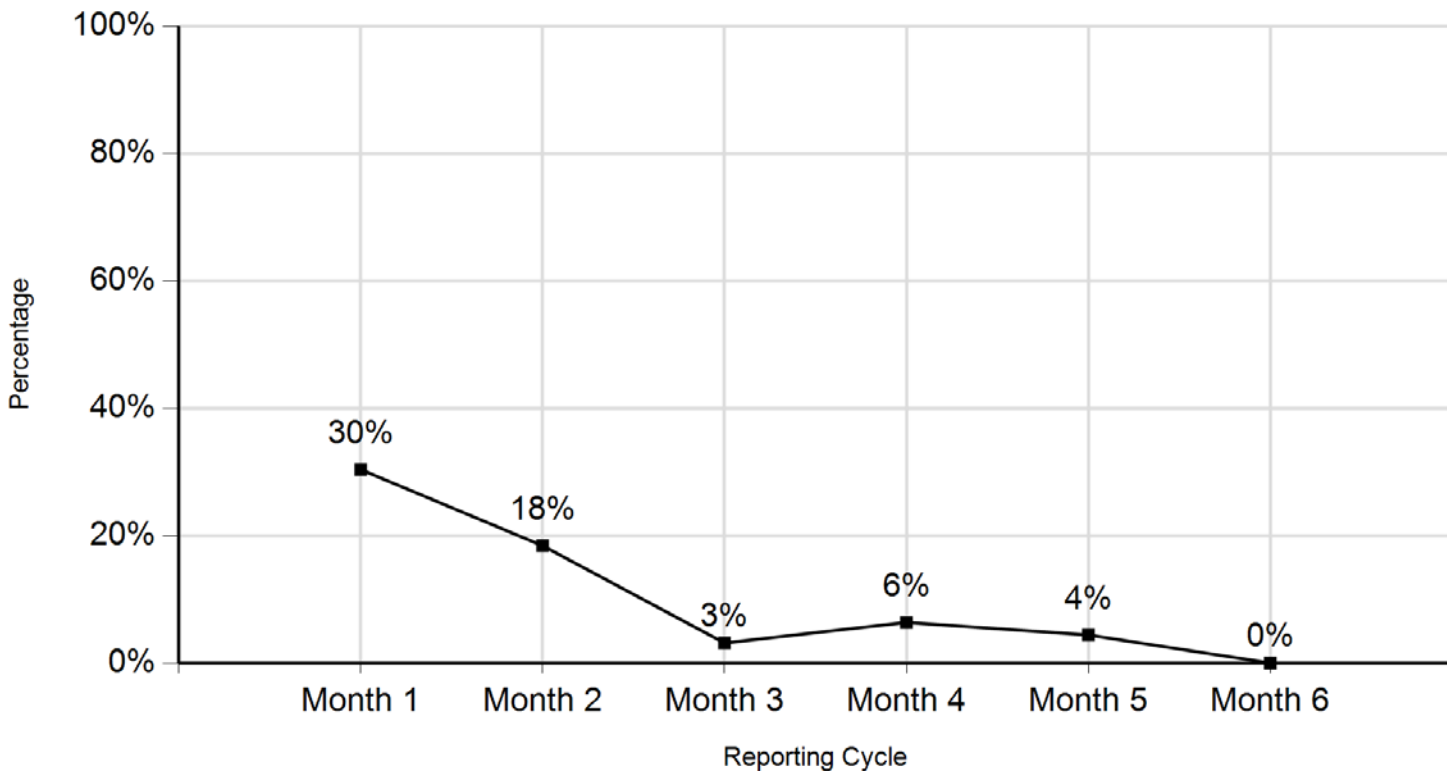
JPB Grant to National Help Me Grow Family Mental Health Project

6 Participating Practices Committed to the Following:

- **Participate in a 45 minute module about maternal depression and family mental health history, screening and referral to *Help Me Grow* and other community resources**
- **Quality Improvement Project:**
 - ✓ **Choose a maternal depression screening tool and incorporate screening into their practices at least three times during the first six months of well-child visits**
 - ✓ **Document the results of the screening**
 - ✓ **Refer all mothers who screen positive on any maternal depression screen to community resources (*Help Me Grow*). Document this referral in the charts.**
 - ✓ **For all patients, ensure that a Family Mental Health history is completed and maintained in the charts.**
 - ✓ **Document evidence that all parents/caregivers are asked if they have any concerns about how their child is developing, behaving or learning and responses should be recorded in the medical record at all well-child visits.**

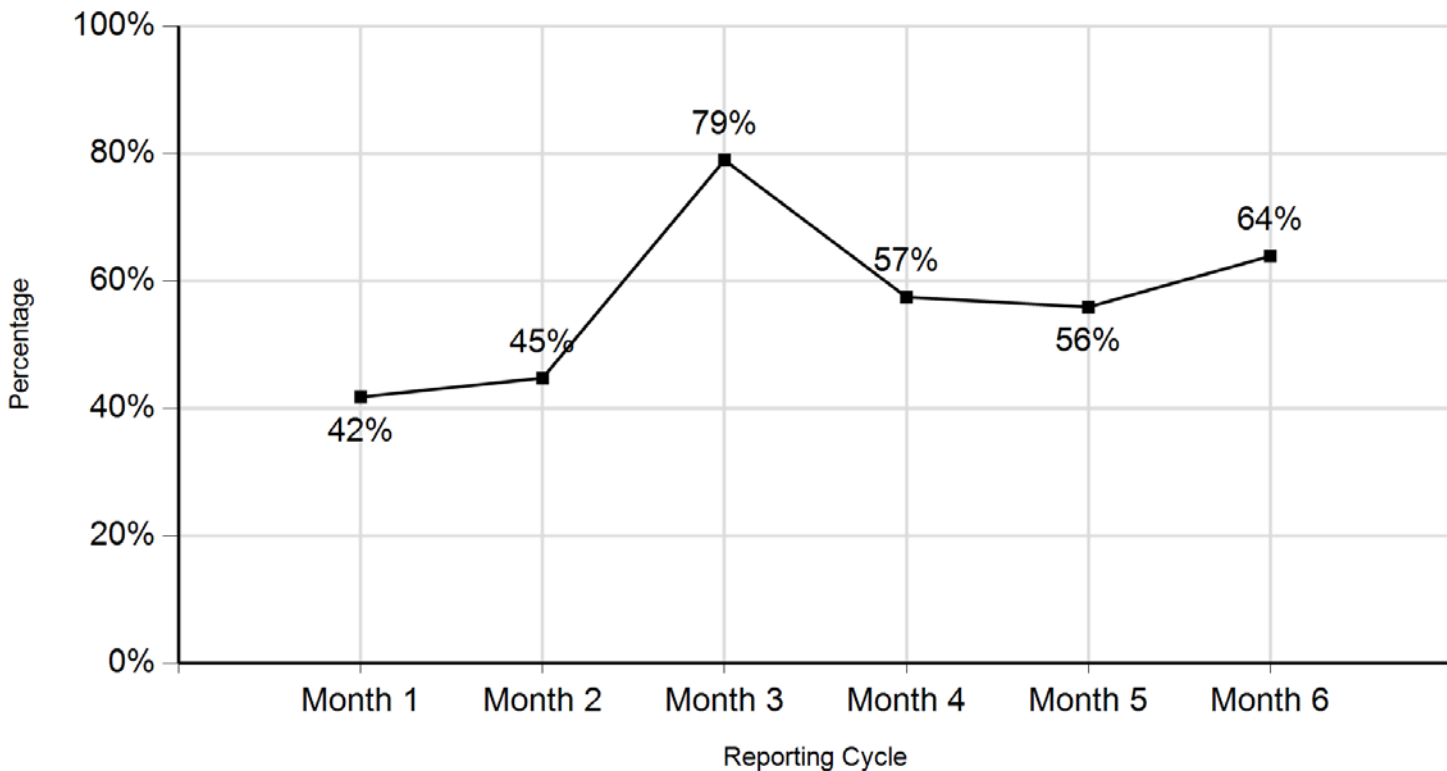
Percent of Charts with 0 Maternal Depression Screenings

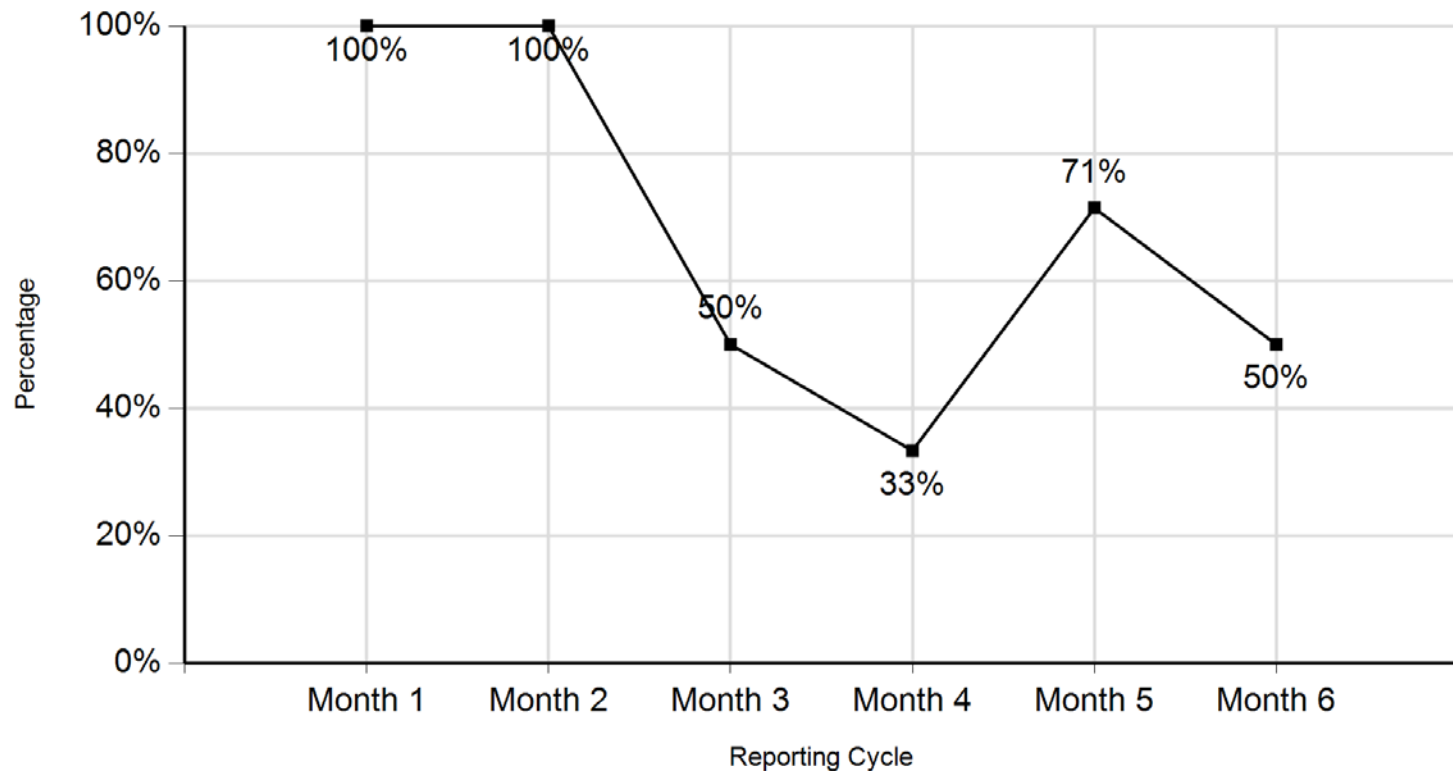
Percent of Charts with 1 Postpartum Depression Screening

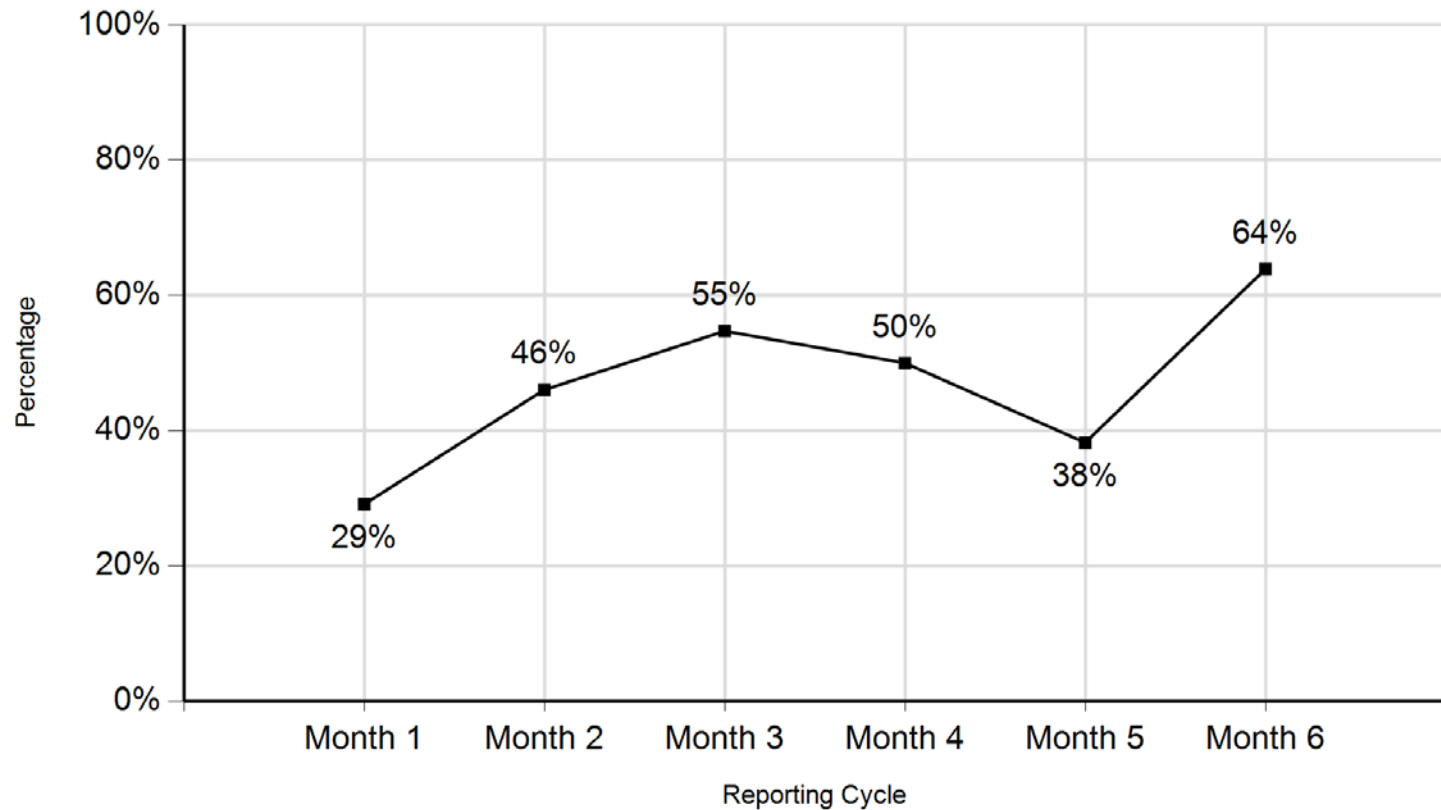
Mothers Who Screen Positive Referred to Community Resources (HMG)

Documentation That All Mothers Who Screen Positive on Any Postpartum Depression Screen Were Referred to Community Resources



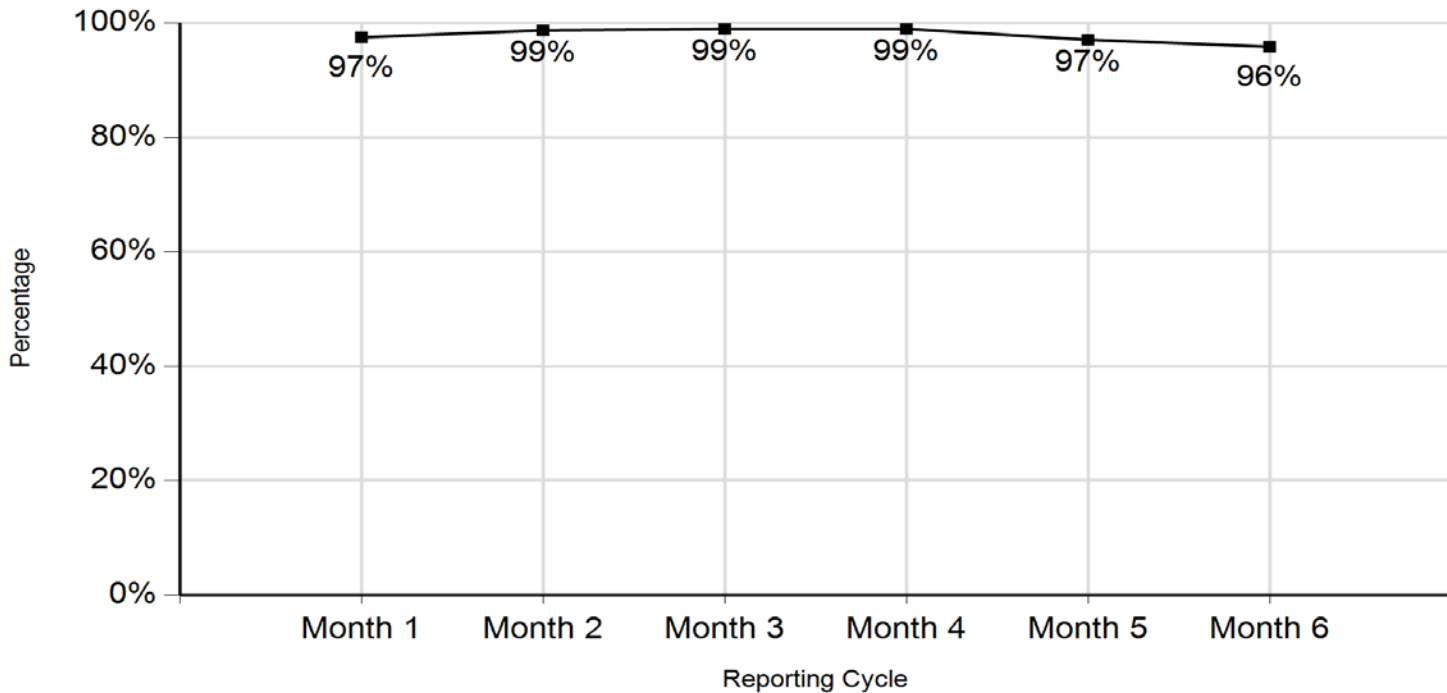
Percent of charts with a completed Family Mental Health History
