

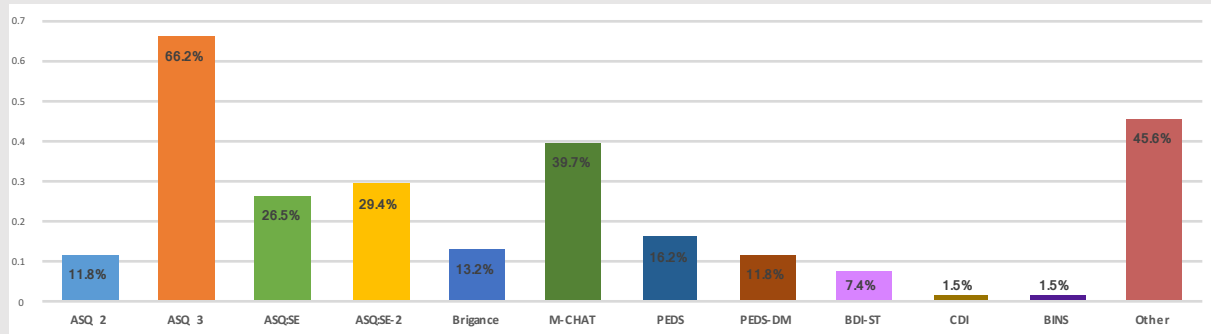
# Developmental Screenings in Alaska

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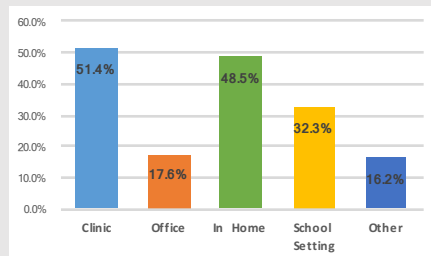
An environmental scan of standardized developmental screenings birth to eight years old was conducted via survey in 2017 by Help Me Grow Alaska with the Governor's Council on Disabilities and Special Education Task Force on Developmental Screening.

This is the first time statewide, multi-disciplinary data regarding screenings has been collected. Six questions from the survey were analyzed here.

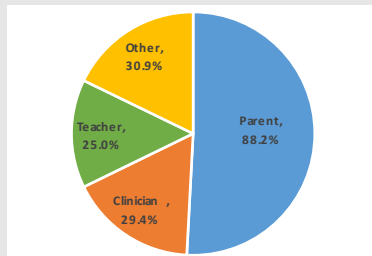
## Types of Screenings Administered n=68



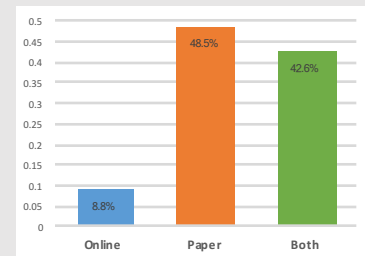
## What is the setting? n=68



## Who is present? n=68



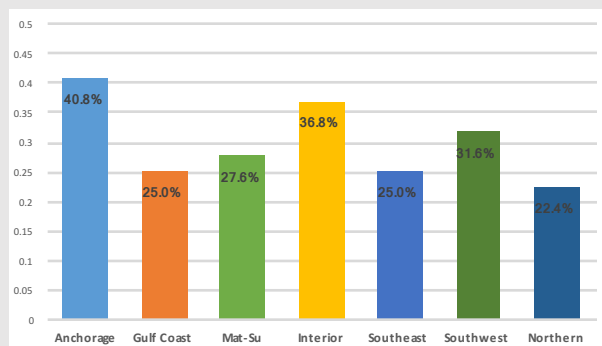
