JOIN THE BUILDING EXPERTISE IN HELP ME GROW MODEL IMPLEMENTATION (BEMI) 2024 LEARNING COMMUNITY



Hosted by the Help Me Grow (HMG) National Center, the Building Expertise in HMG Model Implementation (BEMI) Learning Community provides guided group technical assistance on launching the HMG Model.

Join BEMI to learn:

- How to prepare for implementation;
- Details on the HMG Core Components and their associated Key Activities;
- Various ways the Model has been implemented in affiliate states and communities across the HMG National Network; and
- Approaches to refine and improve HMG efforts once operational.

BEMI provides HMG affiliates with a unique, formal venue to learn about the Model itself and become familiar with an array of approaches to implementation, including best practices, potential challenges to anticipate, and pitfalls to avoid. In addition to its function as a learning space, BEMI offers the opportunity to network and build valuable connections with others across the HMG National Network.

Participation

BEMI is ideal for new HMG systems, new staff joining established systems, as well as longer-standing affiliates that have had significant changes in management/structure and could benefit from a "refresher" on the basics of the HMG Model.

Participants attending live are able to ask questions of presenters, as well as connect with and learn from peers working on HMG across the country. Participants will also have ongoing access to an online BEMI Hub with recordings and curated materials.

Content & Structure

BEMI consists of six, 1.5 hour-long group coaching sessions over the course of 2024 and opportunities to connect with mentors who have experience in implementing the Model. Participants will be expected to complete readings or other prework between sessions to apply learning to their local work.

Session topics will cover:

- Understanding the basics of the HMG Model
- How to message and market the HMG Model
- Approaches to coalition-building
- Strategies to impact system change

Pricing

\$9,000 per participating system (multiple people can participate from each system). Discounted pricing packages are available for multi-system states interested in having multiple systems participate.

Additionally, sessions will offer opportunities for networking, full group discussions, Q&A, and mentorship.

Schedule

BEMI sessions will launch in February 2024 and take place approximately every other month over the course of 2024. Systems are encouraged to sign up by January 31, 2024.
