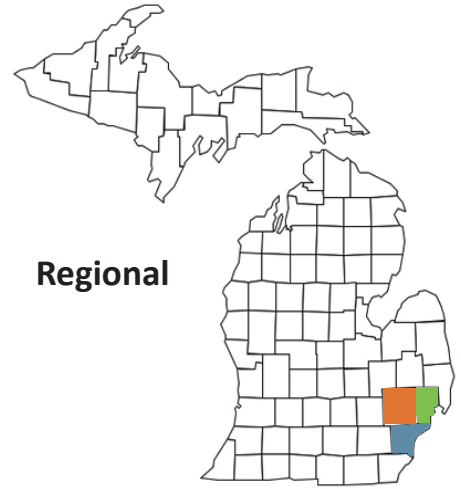

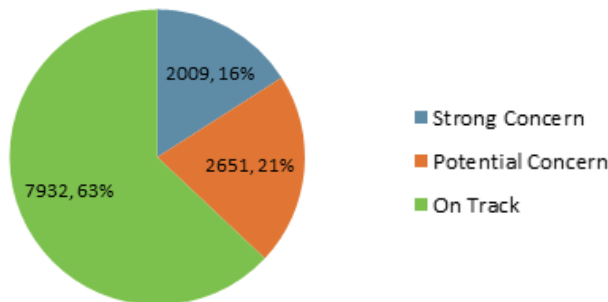

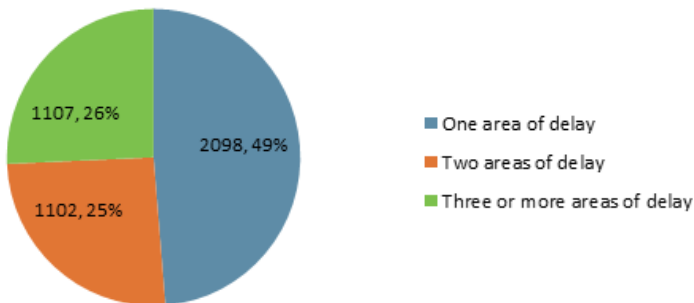

#### Regional



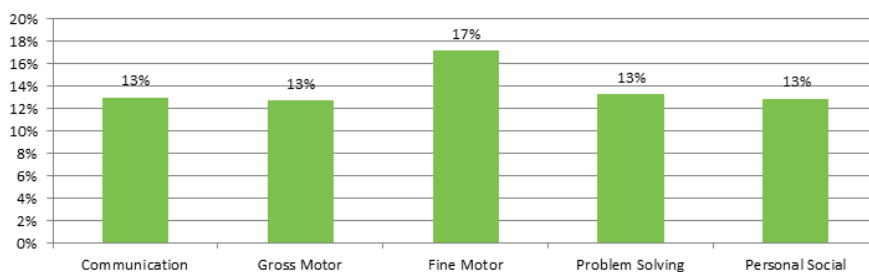
### Number of Areas of Delay

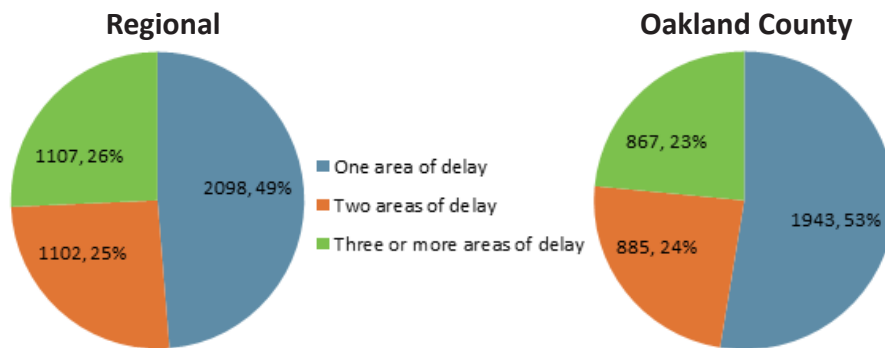

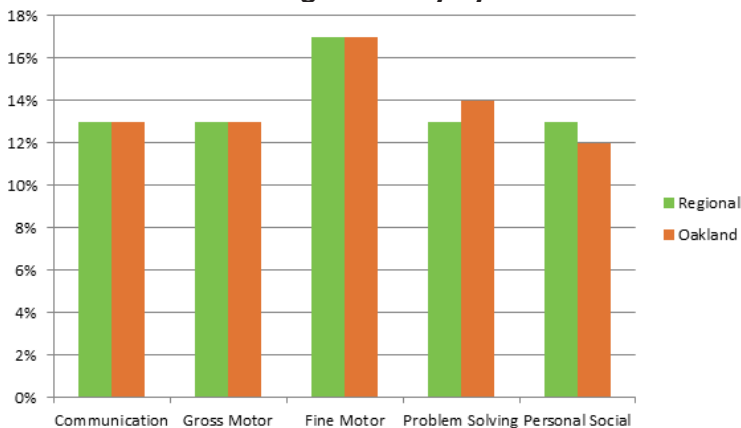

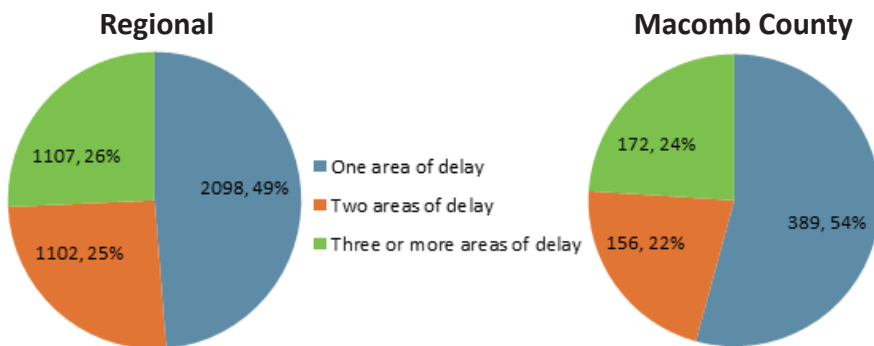

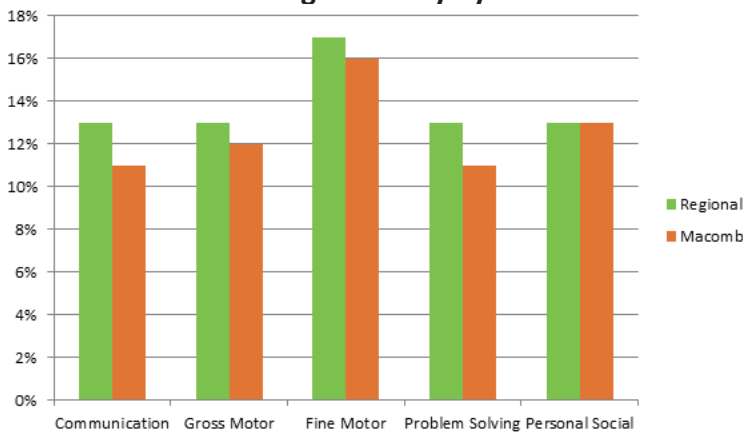

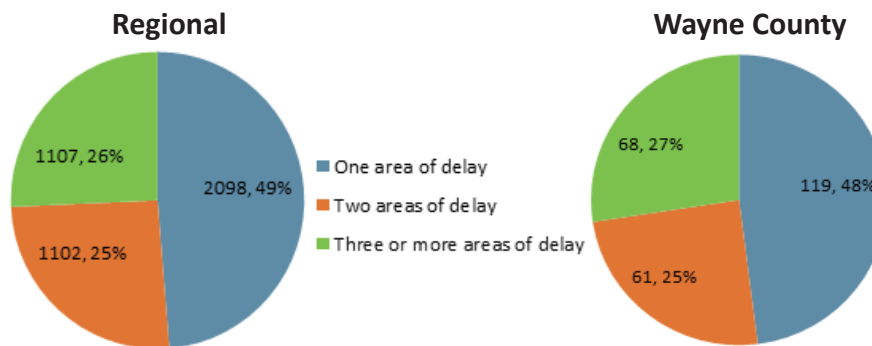

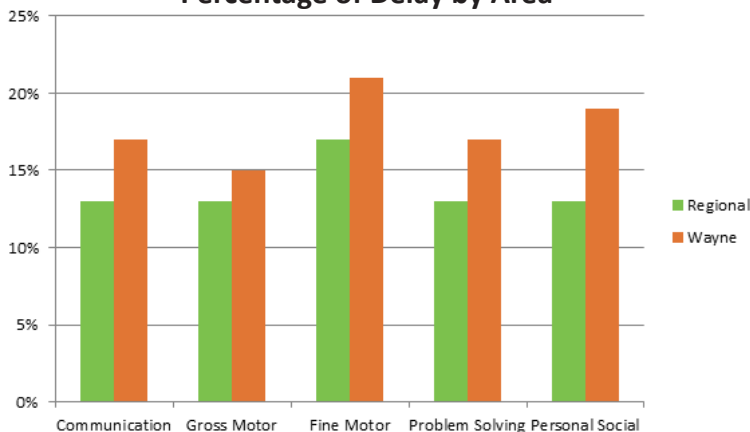
